I recently received the following testimony a few weeks ago from brother Derk through our Facebook page:

"I felt led to share this story with you: 2 children who visit their grandparents who live behind us have been coming over to our house for about a years now to play with my 2 younger boys. They are brother and sister. We do not know their grandparents or their parents very well, we have just always welcomed their kids. We live in the country and their grandparents have always just let them come over and play.

The girl, Lexi, is 6 and the boy, Austin, is 9. We have been blessed to be able to share the truth and the Good News with them and the children come to our Sabbath fellowship whenever they can. They have known Yahweh and Yahushua for some time now, praise Yahweh. Their parents are divorced, and from spending time with them, I think they have had a hard childhood.

About 2weeks ago, their dad came over on his lawn mower with the little girl in his lap. Shortly after, the boy followed. The boy helped me clear some brush and the little girl ran in to say hi to my oldest son. The sun was going down and as I was cleaning up the dad run out of gas, so I offered him some. We talked and I could smell the alcohol on his breath and I wasn't sure if I should witness to him, but then Lexi, his daughter, ran outside and got on the gate and asked her daddy very loudly, "Do you know who Yahushua is?"

He said "no" and Yahweh led me witness to him. He confessed that he drank too much and before he left, I prayed with him in Yahushua's Name and asked him to fellowship with us on the Sabbath. The dad then got on his lawn mower with the 2 children. Lexi on his lap and Austin on the back. The dad had been drinking... I never should have let them leave. I didn't even think about it.

Afterwards, my son said he felt like Yahweh was telling him to stop them. They drove down the driveway and onto the main road for a short distance to then turn up their road and driveway. It was dark by now and before they got there a car crashed into the lawn mower from behind. My son and I screamed "Nooooooo!" and I told my son to call an ambulance as I ran out to the road. I saw the dad on his back on the edge of the road unconscious. My first thought was to go to Lexi and Austin. I saw Austin first and he was sitting in the road crying. I then saw Lexi who was about 30 feet from Austin. I ran to her first. She was sitting out of the road, out of the way, just sitting there. I remember thinking as I ran over to her, it was strange the way she was sitting.

Austin came over to us and I made sure they were okay, and miraculously they seemed fine. I then ran to their dad. He was in and out of consciousness as I prayed with him. Throughout the ordeal Lexi, Austin, my son, his girlfriend, and I all called upon Yahweh's and Yahushua's Name. When their dad was conscious I asked him if he believed in Yahushua and he said "yes". The Paramedics showed up and the Life-Star

Helicopter was called. The children were taken to the hospital in ambulances and their dad was taken on the helicopter. The dad died that night on the way to the hospital but praise Yahweh was revived again. Yahweh allowed him to live. He was out of the hospital the next day with only minor injuries. Lexi and Austin barely had a scratch on them.

Lexi told the doctors and everyone that when the car hit them "she was flying through the air and someone caught her and sat her down in a square". She said it was an angel and that she only saw a blur. I believe her. When I ran out there and saw her sitting there it looked like an angel had placed her there very carefully out of the way. It was a miracle. Logan, my oldest son, said when Lexi was in the house with him, she told Logan that storms scare her. Logan reassured her that Yahweh would protect her from storms and Yahweh did. It was right after this that she ran outside and asked her daddy if he knew who Yahushua was. Praise Yahweh!"

Praise Yahweh indeed! I loved this testimony because it reflected so many things that Yahweh wants to see in our lives. Our children witnessing to other children, fathers of those children being led to our Savior, the power of Yahweh to heal, and His amazing protection over us.

Do we trust Him? And are we willing to boldly declare His ways to our friends and neighbors? Let's not hide our talent in the sand. Now, more than ever, this world needs to know Yahushua.
