## Roman Years: 2025-2026

### About This Calendar

This calendar is an original work created and published through WillYouLoveHim Ministries (WYLH.org). It may be re-distributed for free, but should not be sold. The goal of this calendar is to help you follow our Creator's originally designed calendar and understand what days Biblical events have taken place on throughout the year.

If you see a month appearing twice in this calendar starting on two different days of the week, that means the expected day to see the New Moon in the USA is uncertain and could go either way. For any months with two possible start days where we can't be sure when the moon will be sighted, we have to wait until the night the New Moon is searched for to determine what the outcome will be. For months with only one possible start day, that means the expected USA New Moon sighting appears fairly certain which is why we only include them one time with one starting day and not twice. However, for all months of the year we must actually have witnesses sight the New Moon (which means, technically, we don't know 100% for certain about any month until the New Moon is sighted). This calendar does not take into consideration sightings in Yisra'el because we believe witnesses in the USA should be accepted also. If you go by sightings out of Yisra'el only, please be aware these dates may not match the visual sightings in Yisra'el. We currently do not know anyone personally in Yisra'el to take sighting reports from either who shares the same convictions regarding not using binoculars to first find the moon in the sky and we only take reports of New Moon sightings from people we know because we have to make sure they follow the same standards as us. We have been told by a believer in Messiah who lives in Israel that it is standard practice for most people there to use binoculars first before seeing it with the naked eye (especially if the sky is hazy) and they still report those as "naked-eye" sightings even though binoculars were used first. We do not count those sightings at all because we don't believe binoculars should be used to find the new moon in the sky first before seeing it with your own eyes.

The Wave Sheaf first fruits barley offering of Leviticus 23:11 is a critical command. In order for that command to have been fulfilled properly, barley must be in the Aviv condition that Leviticus 2:14 requires for first fruits to Yahweh (see the Hebrew of Leviticus 2:14). The Aviv condition is a condition necessary on the day of the Wave Sheaf, and we can't prove by Scriptures that it must be in this stage by the New Moon of HaAviv - but we can prove it must be in this stage in sufficient quantity by the Wave Sheaf day. We believe someone with enough experience and understanding can accurately predict this. The Aviv stage of growth is when the barley is "new" and "fresh" and not "too late" in the growth stages, but not "too early" either where it couldn't be parched or roasted to enjoy as food. Some barley declarations today which we believe are declaring the New Year too early would have resulted in there not being sufficient crop of the right quality to give to Yahweh on the Wave Sheaf Day. Although we don't use the equinox, the simple way for you to understand which declarations we believe are too early would be by noticing when declarations result in 100% of their first Biblical month being completely before the equinox. We have never had this happen with the barley findings we use.

Some new year declarations use an "equinox on or before New Moon" methodology instead of observing barley development. That view is that the New Moon of HaAviv must be on or after the equinox. But in some years (usually years when a New Moon is closer to the equinox but before, and with the majority of the days in the month after the equinox) these declarations requiring the New Moon be "on or after equinox" are actually placing the first month further away from the equinox and end up also being too late by placing the Wave Sheaf first fruits barley offering of Leviticus 23:11 4-5 weeks after this calendar. It should be obvious that if we expect the barley to be in the correct Aviv stage on the Wave Sheaf day on this calendar, then it would be impossible 4-5 weeks later to still be in that exact same new, fresh, Aviv stage. Those 4-5 additional weeks are critical and the barley would no longer be in the "best quality" condition to fulfill the command in the "exact best same way" 4-5 weeks later if it already hit that point of the growth stages with the correct quality and quantity 4-5 weeks before. Also, there is sufficient Scriptural evidence the first month of the Biblical year has to be early enough to permit barley harvest to begin as early as possible to not lose crops since it could not be harvested until the Wave Sheaf offering in Leviticus 23:11 according to Deuteronomy 16:9-10 and Leviticus 23:14 (also see Exo. 9:31-32, Lev. 2:14, Lev. 23:10-14, Deut. 16:1).

Even if someone could prove you "must" use the equinox, we don't believe anyone can prove "how" to use it. If the equinox is a marker, would it not mark the end of a year as well as the beginning? And, if so, does it make logical sense, for example, to assign a month to "last year" when only a **minority** percentage of the days of that month are before the equinox? We don't believe the equinox is the method to use, but if it were, there are no Scriptures to prove it shouldn't be the New Moon "closest" to the equinox, not after the equinox and further away from the equinox (like when a new moon happens a week before, for example). If the equinox were the marker, or in an emergency where we need to declare the Biblical New Year when barley searches can't be conducted as normal for a long period of time, then it should be sufficient that the feast days (not necessarily the New Moon) are "on or after the equinox" to say that they are "in season". The "new moon **closest** to the equinox" or "majority of days after equinox" methodology happens to also, generally speaking, usually line up with barley findings. If you use the "New Moon closest to equinox method", then the view of using the "New Moon on or after equinox method" still appears to be waiting an extra month in some years and putting the feast days out of season and late by a month. But we believe Scriptures lead us to pay attention to the barley while we have good quality barley searches and findings available to us.

It is noteworthy that sufficient Scriptural evidence shows the Harvest **itself** is how we start the Biblical year. By observing barley development, we believe the timing for the first month will match what they did anciently. We believe Genesis 1:14-15 supports focusing on the Harvest, not the equinox. Light is for the land (Gen. 1:15), and light creates heat, which brings seasonal changes from winter to summer (Gen. 8:22) when the year starts and Harvest begins (there is only winter and summer in the Bible). The equinox is not an Appointed Time mentioned in Leviticus 23, but the Harvest is. The equinox has no spiritual significance and there are no parables about the equinox, but the Harvest does have great spiritual significance and is used in important parables the Messiah shared. Clearly, the Harvest cannot be ignored or set aside and it is a critical component of the Biblical Calendar. Also, unharvested barley could be ruined if left on the stalk to wait for the equinox to start some years, which is further evidence in some years it is impossible to wait for the equinox. The difference is an additional 4-5 weeks of barley growth development from the 'Barley Wave Sheaf Day' (which seems to always be on or after equinox) to the 'Equinox Wave Sheaf Day' (where the **New Moon** is also after Equinox). Clearly, if barley is in the Aviv stage on the 'Barley Wave Sheaf Day', after 4-5 weeks of growth it will not be in that same stage anymore. The Heavenly Father would not bring a harvest that He expects you to let go to waste. Mark 4:29 "And when the crop is ready, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come." Considering all these things, it's clear the month of HaAviv has to occur when the first-fruits of barley are in the stage of Aviv because by 4 weeks later it would no longer qualify for the Lev. 2:14 Aviv stage of growth. **In cases where the barley is in that Aviv stage of growth even before the New Moon before equinox, we're talking about at least a full 6 weeks later to the much further out 'Equinox Wave Sheaf Day' which ironically is even further from the point of the equinox than the 'Barley Wave Sheaf Day', and, at that point, the first-fruits and other barley fields could have been lost. Does it make more sense to have Wave Sheaf day on or after equinox, or a month after equinox simply because of when the New Moon happens? Scriptures show if the barley was ready, you wouldn't wait another month.**

Regarding the Omer Count, Leviticus 23:16 shows that the 50th day in the count would be "the morrow after the seventh Sabbath", Leviticus 23:14 with Joshua 5:10-11 shows the Omer count must have started that year on the 15th on the first day of the week since they ate roasted/parched (which means new Aviv grain) on the 15th, and when Messiah rose, it was on the 17th on the 1st day of the week also (and He is the first-fruits according to 1 Cor. 15:20-23). All of this is enough evidence to conclude the Sabbath of Leviticus 23:11 was a weekly Sabbath and that our counting method is correct.
